What are the requirements?

- Must be 21 years of age or older
- Must have valid HS diploma or G.E.D.
- Must have a valid P.A. Driver's license, and a minimum of 1 year driving experience
- Must provide a P.A. Department of Transportation Drug Screen
- Must provide a P.A. Department of Transportation Physical exam.
- Must provide Motor Vehicle Report – Acceptable Driving Record
- Must provide a current Criminal Background check (within the last 30 days)
